Notes:

- (1) Students within normal term of study should pay the full amount of tuition and miscellaneous fees.
- (2) Students within extension term of study should pay the credit fee and the miscellaneous fees in accordance with the credit hours every week. Students who take fewer than nine credits/hours (including nine credits/hours) should pay the miscellaneous fee unit and credit fee by the number of credit/hour. Students who take more than ten credits/hours (including ten credits/hours) should pay the full tuition and miscellaneous fees.
- (3) The credit fee of summer study is charged in accordance with “NUK Regulations on Opening Classes of Summer Study.” If the credit of the course is 0, the students are charged by the instruction hours.
- (4) Day-time program students who have paid the full tuition and the miscellaneous fees do not need to pay credit fees if they take the courses offered in other programs. Day-time program students paying the credit fees need to pay the relevant fees stated in the attached table if they take the courses offered in other programs.
- (5) For students of CDA admitted before 2011-2012 academic year, the charge standard of the tuition and the miscellaneous fees stays the same; for students admitted before 2012-2013 academic year, the charge standard of the tuition and the miscellaneous is based on that of College of Engineering; for transfer students, the charge standard of the tuition and the miscellaneous is the same as the students of the classes they transfer to.

Freshmen of day-time program undergraduates of non-DWLL who were admitted before 2006-2007 academic year (included) should pay this fee each semester; those undergraduates who were admitted after 2007-2008 academic year (included) should pay this fee if they utilize the language facility in the multi-media lab. (Freshmen should pay this fee at the time of enrollment, and the fee will be returned after the course adding/dropping comes to an end; non-freshmen should pay this fee at after the course adding/dropping comes to an end, and the fee will be collected in accordance with the real situation.

Student Dormitory Margin	2,000	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Those who apply to live in the dormitory for the first time. 2. Those who have lived in the dormitory for one semester and have registered to continue living in it for the second semester do not need to pay the deposit again.
Student Insurance	325	Collected once each semester.
Foreign Student Insurance (freshman)	3,000	Newly immigrated overseas Chinese should pay the medical injury group insurance NTD\$3,000 for the first semester; those are not qualified for being included in National Health Insurance should pay NTD\$ 500 .
Foreign Student National Health Insurance	4,494	Those who have resided consecutively for more than six months, and are qualified for being included in National Health Insurance should pay NTD\$ 749 .
<p>According to the twenty-first paragraph of "Regulations for Foreign Students Applying to Study in Taiwan." foreign students should submit the document of four-month (at least) medical and injury insurance which is effective since the date of immigration when they enrolled as freshmen of NUK; afterwards, they should submit the certified document of National Health Insurance.</p>
