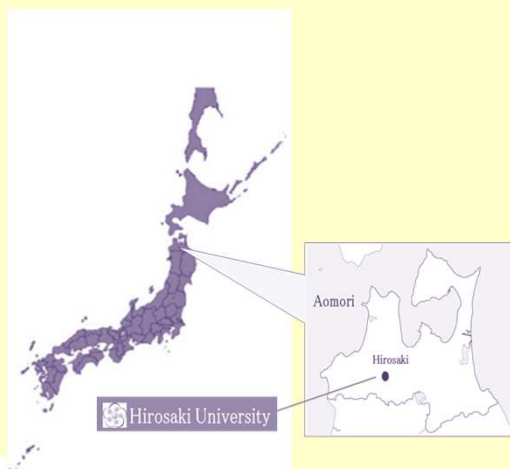

Program Details

1. Program Fees

Approx. 50,000JPY will cover the following costs.

- ◆ Accommodation (including bedding, cleaning, and utilities such as electricity, water and gas)
- ◆ Activities

Clear program fee will be informed with results of application.

2. Other Expenses

Participants are required to buy their own

- ◆ Flight ticket
- ◆ Travel insurance
- ◆ Food

3. Contents

- ◆ Japanese Class (basic level)
- ◆ Cultural Activities (visiting historical sites, Japanese and local cultural experience)

4. Total number of participants

The maximum number of participants to be accepted is 10 in total.

Participants will receive notification regarding the results of their application through their home university

5. Credit Recognition

Participants who successfully complete the program will earn 2 credits as follows.

Japanese Language and Culture: 2 credits

Successful participants will be also issued a certificate of completion.

6. Accommodation (International House)

Check in : June 10th

Check out : June 24th

Room type : Shared room (2 to 3 participants per room)

Facilities : Bed, Bedding, Table, Chair, Bathroom, Washing machine, Refrigerator, Vacuum cleaner, Free Wi-Fi
(Does not have towels, detergents, toiletries and toilet paper)

7. English Proficiency

Participants should be proficient in English.
As a rough indication, the following level is required.

- ◆ TOEFL-iBT: 61
- ◆ TOEFL- PBT : 500
- ◆ IELTS : 5.0
